In Matthew 28, Jesus gives his final words to his disciples before he ascends to Sundays heaven. Typically, someone's departing words indicate what is important to them. Here we see that at the very heart of our Lord is for the church to, "Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you" (Matthew 28:19-20).

Jesus calls us to not stay in our churches but calls us to go and reach all nations with the gospel. The last I checked, this is not called the great suggestion, but the Great Commission. That means if we as a church stop at just reaching those in our church or even our community for Jesus we are in disobedience. God calls us to reach the Grand Strand, The United States, Egypt, Russia, and China for him.

Certainly, that is a task much greater than just First Baptist Surfside. That is a task for all believers. However, what does it look like for us to go? It looks like us being faithful to use the resources God has given us to accomplish his mission in the most effective way we can. We may not reach millions for Christ, but we can come alongside of mission partners nationally and internationally to assist them in the work they are doing.

This coming Monday, a small team from our church and association will be going on a vision trip to NYC. Our goal is to meet with several church planters in hopes of establishing at least one mission partner in the city. Our hope is to find a church that we can support through prayer, providing financial support, and even participating in what God is doing through sending mission teams.

Would you pray for us as we go next week? Would you pray for safety, but more than anything that we would be sensitive to the Holy Spirit's leading? In Christ,
