YOU CAN PRAY: Pray for those who have lost family members, homes, and businesses and who are still without water, food, and power. Pray also for first responders and disaster relief volunteers who are assisting and sharing the gospel. YOU CAN GIVE: Donations can be made directly to our church but please remember to mark your check or evenlope "For Disaster Relief".

YOU CAN DONATE RESOURCES: We are receiving various requests for donations. When we receive them, we will forward them to you, through email.

YOU CAN TRAIN AND GO: When a disaster strikes we are blessed to have an army of Southern Baptist volunteers who immediately are deployed on the front lines to assist those who are hurting. Those volunteers are trained Disaster Relief volunteers and you can be a part of this ministry. Teams of volunteers will be needed for many months ahead to assist in these devastated areas. We encourage you to consider a Disaster Relief Training that is coming up next week.

Sign up to attend Disaster Relief Training at First Baptist Church Spartanburg on Saturday, October 12. An "Introduction to Disaster Relief" class is required of all new volunteers. The day will include three training class times, a general session, a regional meeting, and lunch.
